

Programme of Study



Subject: Latin

Year: 7

Autumn 1

Introduction to Latin conventions, masculine and feminine nouns, singular verb endings and greetings.

Initial study of Pompeii site and introductory stories about the fictional family whose adventures we follow.
Detailed study of the house and daily life of an upper class Roman household.

Autumn 2

Study of the daily life and food of ancient Pompeii.

Continuation of Latin grammar including the nominative and accusative singular and standard Latin sentence pattern.

Spring 1

Study of town life and business in ancient Pompeii.

Continuation of Latin grammar including the nominative and accusative singular of first, second and third declensions.

Spring 2

Study of finance, law courts and the forum at Pompeii.

Continuation of Latin grammar including present first and second person singular.

Summer 1

Study of the theatre through actors and performances and the genres of pantomime and comedy.

Continuation of Latin grammar including the nominative plural and present third person plural.

Summer 2

Study of slaves and freedmen.

Continuation of Latin grammar including the perfect and imperfect third person singular and plural.
