






FACE OF CHRIST

Jesus said to Levi, 'Come, follow me...'




The Leper






Reconciliation

They were complaining because he ate with sinners, so he told them this story...



for the forgiveness of sins





The Sacrifice that Heals a broken world

the pain that was ours to bear.


All the while we thought his suffering was a

*(Matthew 18:12 - 14)***






This is my faithful servant in whom I delight,

Tell souls where they are to look for help; that is, in the Court of Mercy (the Sacrament of Confession). There the greatest miracles take place and are continually repeated. To benefit from this miracle, it is not necessary to go on a great pilgrimage or to carry out some external ceremony; you only need to come with faith to the feet of My representative (the priest in Confession) and to reveal to him your misery.

In the Sacrament of Confession the miracle of Divine Mercy will be fully demonstrated. If someone's soul was like a decaying corpse so that from a human standpoint, there would be no hope of salvation and everything would already be lost, it is not so with God. The miracle of Divine Mercy restores that soul in full (*Diary*, 1448).
